RECOVERY trial DMC report in response to presentation of REMAP CAP oseltamivir data

We have reviewed the data presented at the recent CCR conference on the results of the Oseltamivir comparisons among the 443 participants with severe influenza requiring organ support in the REMAPCAP trial, together with the RECOVERY trial safety and efficacy data that were available for patients randomised by 11th May 2026.

In the light of the available trial data and all relevant external information, we saw no cogent reason to modify the protocol or intake to the study.

The DMC will next review the data for all treatments in about 6 months time (or sooner if there is a marked increase in recruitment).
