The Associate PI Scheme is open to any health and care professional working in the UK, not currently fully funded to work on research.

## What is the Associate Principal Investigator Scheme?

The Associate Principal Investigator Scheme (PI) is a 6 month in-work training opportunity, providing practical experience for health and care professionals starting their research career.



### How it works

Successful applicants will:

- ▶ Be mentored by a local PI over a period of 6 months.
- ▶ Work through a checklist of activities that will enhance skills and understanding of study delivery.
- ▶ Receive Royal College and NIHR-endorsed certification as an Associate PI once complete.
