RECOVERY trial DMC report

The RECOVERY trial DMC reviewed the safety and efficacy data that were available today for the 39,442 patients randomised (including 104 women who were pregnant at entry). For the interventions still in active recruitment, the numbers included in the comparison of each agent with its control were respectively: REGN-COV2 (9,601), baricitinib (3,008) and dimethyl fumarate (42).

For the children recruited in the study, the numbers included in the comparison of each agent with its control were: Intravenous gammaglobulin (116) and Methylprednisolone (116) with smaller numbers in the comparisons of tocilizumab (45), anakinra (9) REGN-COV2 (11) and baricitinib (4).

In the light of the available trial data and all relevant external information, we saw no cogent reason to modify the protocol or intake to the study.

The full DMC will next meet to review the safety and efficacy data for all treatments on 30th April 2021.
