RECOVERY trial DMC report

Today we reviewed the RECOVERY trial safety and efficacy data that were available for patients randomised by 7th June 2022.

For the interventions still in active recruitment, the numbers of adults included in the comparison of each agent with its control were respectively: high dose steroids (411), empagliflozin (3762), sotrovimab (1070), molnupiravir (540) and paxlovid (32). The dataset included 4 women who were pregnant at entry and 4 children.

In the light of the available trial data and all relevant external information, we saw no cogent reason to modify the protocol or intake to the study.

In view of the anticipated recruitment rate, there will be a Chairman's review in September 2022 and the full DMC will next meet to review the safety and efficacy data for all treatments in about 6 months' time. The meeting schedule may be adapted if the incidence of COVID19 increases again.
