### **RECOVERY trial DMC report**

We reviewed the RECOVERY trial safety and efficacy data that were available today for the 40,099 patients randomised (including 101 women who were pregnant at entry).

For the interventions still in active recruitment, the numbers of adults included in the comparison of each agent with its control were respectively: baricitinib (3,467), dimethyl fumarate (133) and high dose steroids (109).

The numbers of children included in the comparison of each agent with its control were: Intravenous gammaglobulin (126), Methylprednisolone (124), with smaller numbers in the comparisons of tocilizumab (47), anakinra (14) and baricitinib (6).

In the light of the available trial data and all relevant external information, we saw no cogent reason to modify the protocol or intake to the study.

The DMC will next meet to review the safety and efficacy data for all treatments on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2021.
